story / song

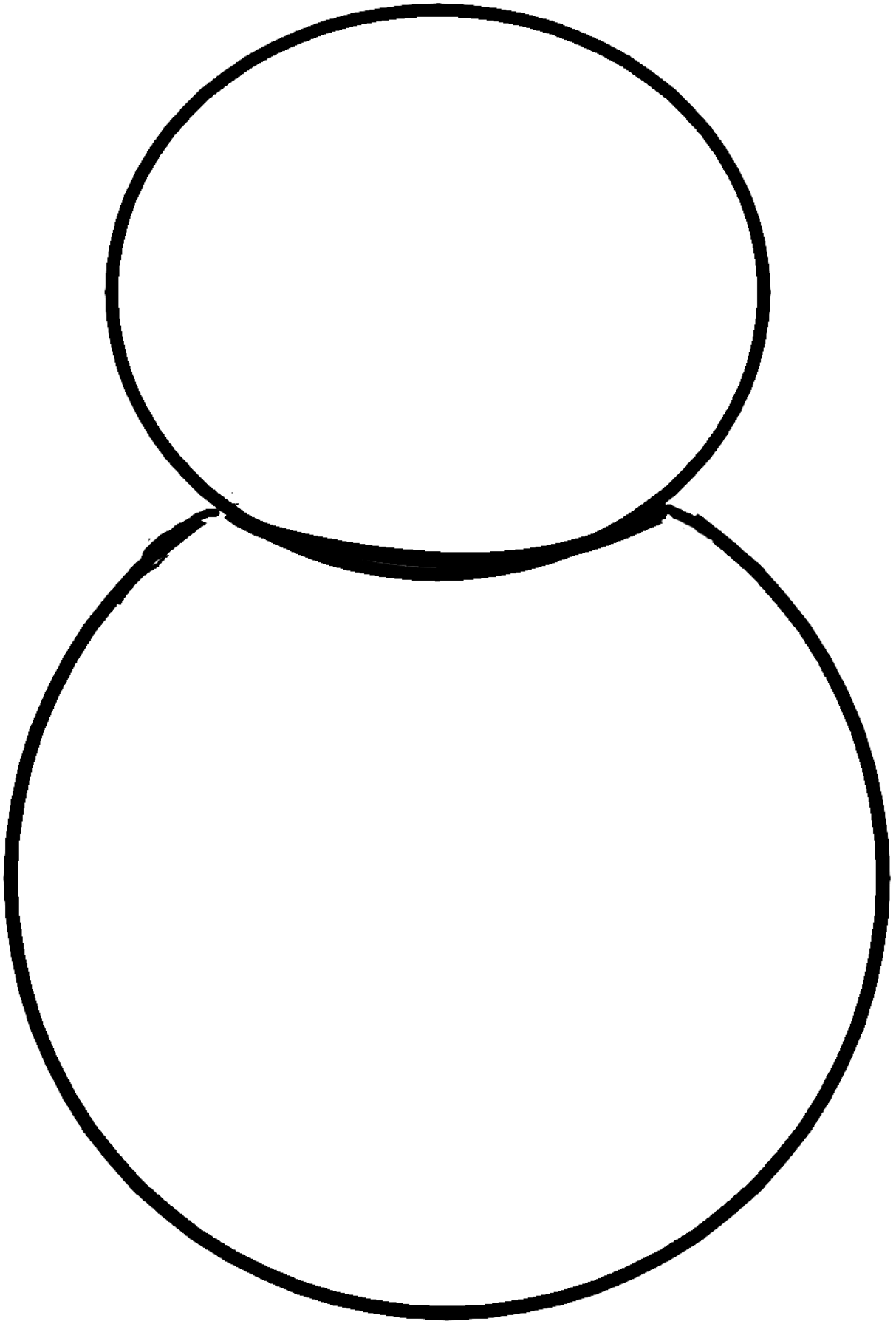


Instructions for Assembling and Using the Story;

- **You can also laminate all the patterns, cut each piece out, attach velcro dots or use magnetic tape to attach to the board of your choice.**

- **The children love this story!**

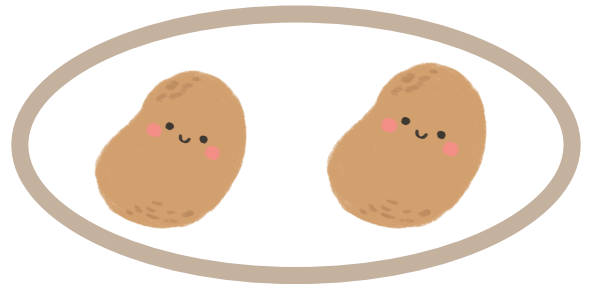


Snowman templete

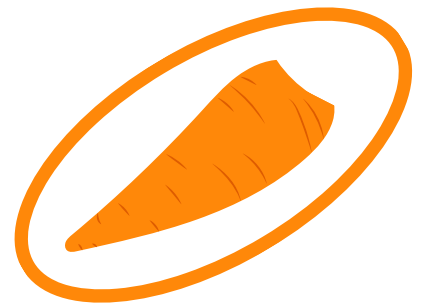

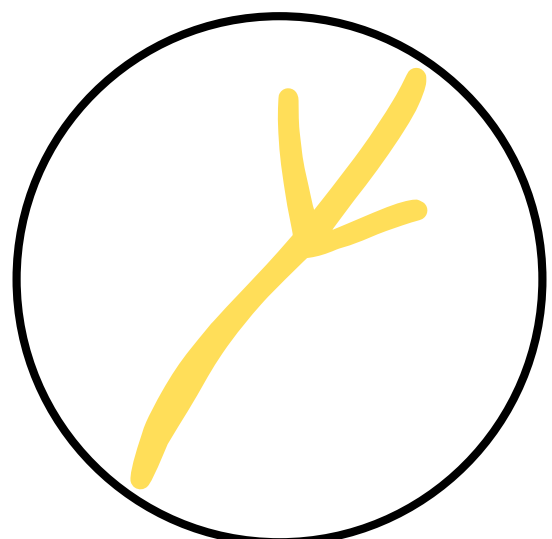
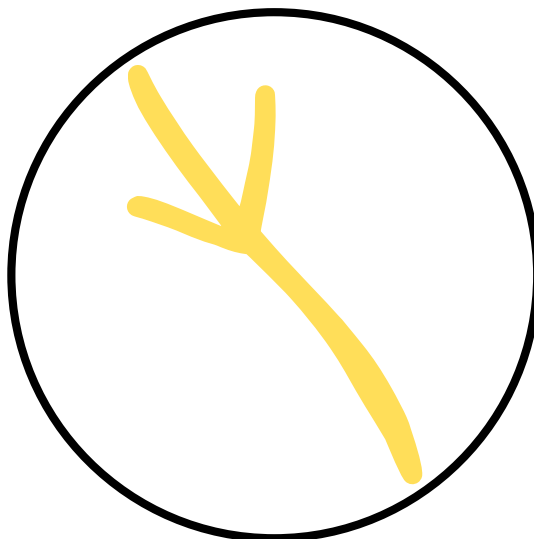
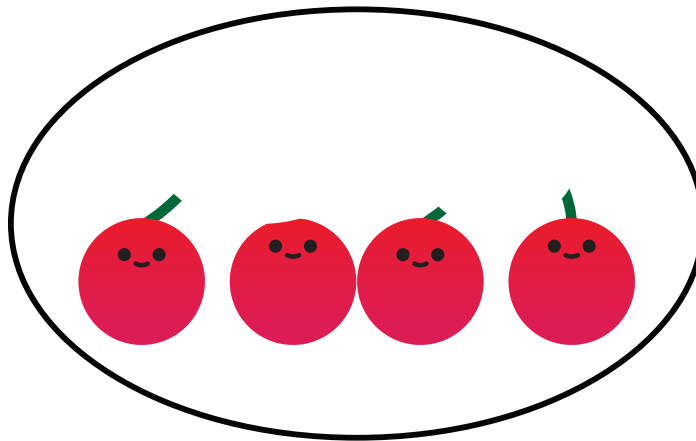


Brown potato eyes

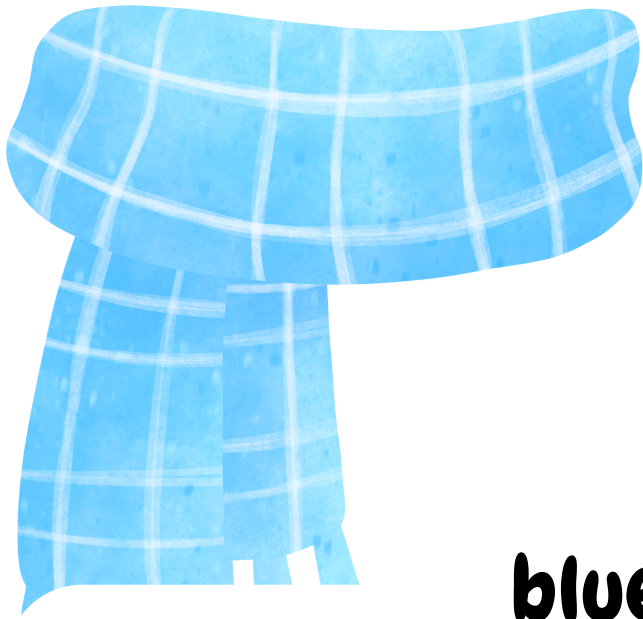

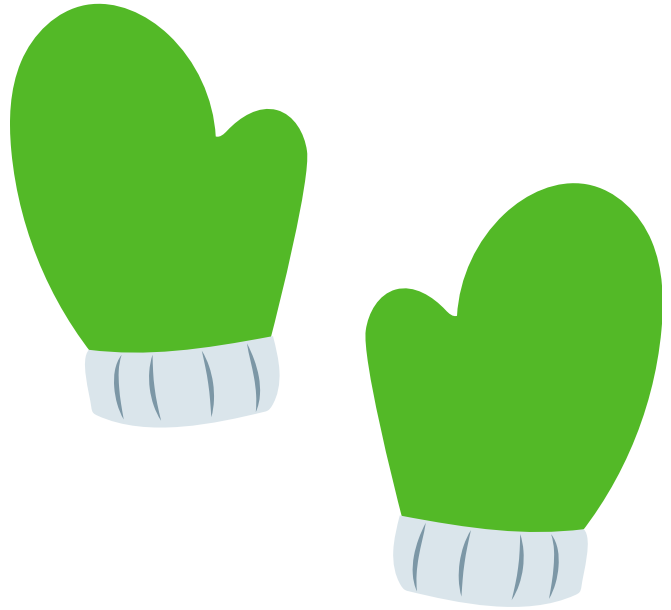
