

Mini Snow Unit for Bible Class or Preschool

Dear Teachers,

I have used this mini unit in Bible class several times
with children ranging from 2- 4 or 5 years old.

This unit captured each child's attention so I thought you might find it
useful.

I stored a small bag of snow in my freezer for class.
I sent home the page pictured on the left with the scripture reference
and image to color, dot paint, attach cotton balls, etc.

The main purpose for sending home the snowman page was to provide a
connection between home and class and to let the parents know about
our classroom activities. Obviously, some children will enjoy coloring
while others will not and that's perfectly fine.

I let each child touch and feel the (real) snow and we talked about how
the snow felt, etc. Most importantly, we talked about God who made the
snow, sang songs from the sheet pictured on the left, and I also used a
felt story about a snowman that I have shared in this freebie unit.

The children had lots of fun! If you are teaching a preschool class, you
might consider using "real" snow in a sensory bin with toy arctic animals,
etc.

As you probably know, being able to "experience" the snow with multiple
senses enhances the learning process significantly.
