TUNE: The Bus Song

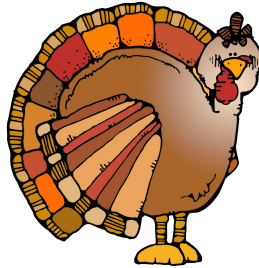
The turkeys in the barn yard
